**Commonhold | Law Commission**

A commonhold can be a new building or an existing building, or land which has not been built on. Once the commonhold is in place, the new law provides a formal framework of the rights and obligations that apply between the unit-holders, and between the unit-holders and the commonhold association. The framework is relatively simple.

**Commonhold - The Leasehold Advisory Service**

The Law Society is keen for commonhold to become the preferred alternative to leasehold. It proposes placing leaseholders in control of the conversion process; preventing a veto from those who are opposed; and enabling conversion to commonhold without the agreement of every person, with safeguarding in place to protect those who have not agreed.

Commonhold involves flat buyers owning the freehold to their individual property and forming a company with other residents to manage shared areas, removing the need for freeholders and third-party management companies.

Commonhold is a type of property ownership that sits amongst leasehold and freehold ownership; and is applicable to new or existing buildings. Prescribed by the Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Act 2002, commonhold applies to purpose-built blocks of flats, converted buildings containing flats, houses and commercial buildings.

Under the 2002 Act, conversion to commonhold requires the consent of: 1. The freeholder; 2. All long leaseholders; and, 3. All mortgagees of long leaseholders. If the freeholder does not agree to the conversation, then collective enfranchisement may be necessary to change the freeholder and enable the process.

Commonhold is a system of property ownership in England and Wales. It involves the indefinite freehold tenure of part of a multi-occupancy building (typically a flat) with shared ownership of and responsibility for common areas and services.

The Law Commission has today (21 st July) published three reports with an extensive series of proposed legislative changes for leasehold enfranchisement, the right to manage, and commonhold. The Commission was tasked by the Government to improve consumer choice and provide greater fairness and transparency for leaseholders.

The majority of those that are now commonhold are newbuilds where the developer has signed over the land as commonhold to the flat owners. This land is registered as commonhold rather than freehold with each individual flat owner, referred to in law as a Unit Owner, having absolute ownership of their property in perpetuity.
